## Notice of Possible Change of Benefit Program (Request for Information to Continue Payment of Weekly Benefits)

Our records show that your current payments will end . However, you may be able to continue to receive weekly benefits.

You previously filed a claim for Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA) but reported you performed work in a state outside of Illinois after your last day of work for . You may be eligible to be paid unemployment in the other state. Before benefits under the Trade Act can continue to be paid to you, you must file an unemployment insurance claim in the state of . To get information on how to file an unemployment claim in the state of , please call your local office at the phone number listed above. You should inform your local office in Illinois if you are told by the state of that you are not eligible for unemployment insurance benefits in the state of .

You are exhausting your Illinois unemployment insurance benefits and our records show you previously filed a claim for Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA). Our records show your last day of work for was . If you worked for after this date, you must report the last date you worked to your local office at the phone number listed above. If you do not provide a different last day of work for , the period during which your basic Trade Act benefits are payable to you will be to . Your claim for Trade Act benefits will be effective .

Currently, your weekly benefit payments are based on your Trade Readjustment Assistance (TRA) claim. Federal Law requires that you file a new claim for Illinois state unemployment insurance effective rather than Federal TRA benefits. We will process your claim automatically and there is no need for you to report. Our records show that you last worked for on . Please contact your local office at the phone number listed above if this information is not correct. PLEASE NOTE: An eligible Illinois Unemployment Insurance claim may change your weekly benefit amount. When your claim is processed, you will be sent a written Finding regarding your eligibility for Illinois Unemployment Insurance benefits.

Currently, your weekly benefit payments are based on your Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA) claim. Federal Law requires that you file a new claim for Illinois state unemployment insurance effective and we will automatically process your claim. There is no need for you to report. Our records show that you last worked for on . When your claim is processed, you will be sent a written Finding.

You will continue to be paid TRA benefits unless you contact your local office at the phone number listed above and let us know the information on the Finding is not correct.
