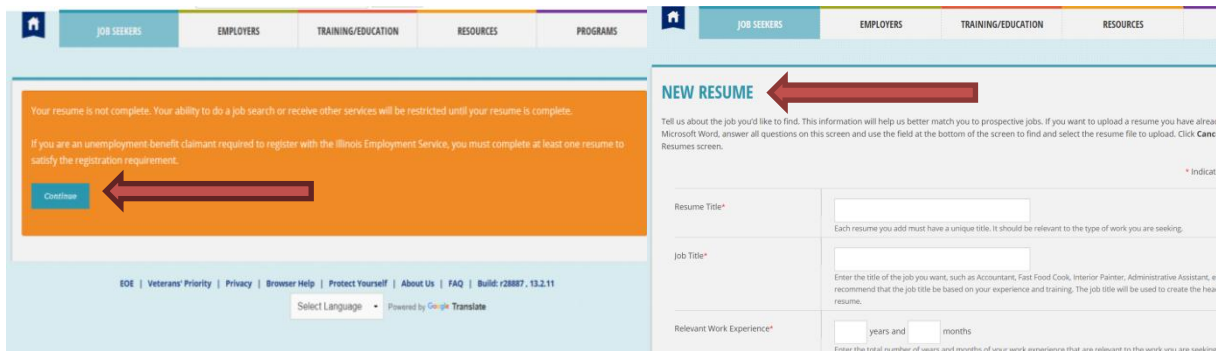


Job Seeker's view when resume is missing or expired

When a job seeker logs in and does not have a resume or has one that has expired, an orange block will come into context with the message: "Your resume is not complete. Your ability to do a job search or receive other services will be restricted until your resume is complete. If you are an unemployment-benefit claimant required to register with the Illinois Employment Service, you must complete at least one resume to satisfy the registration requirement."

When "Continue" is selected, the job seeker will be directed to the "New Resume" page so that a resume can be uploaded or completed using the IJL Resume Builder.



Once a resume is created and is active, the "My Home Page" will populate and look like the screenshot below. The second link on the left-hand side will show an indicator, "UI Registered" for a job seeker that has an active UI enrollment. This indicator will remain for the benefit year regardless of whether UI benefits are being collected.
